Old Business

Access to range equipment.

John Hartsock is trying to raise the prestige of Range Officers. Previously 50% of members were ROs. Currently 36% are ROs. There will be a RO class at TargetMasters in August.

Recommendation to require a certified RO to shoot alone. Motioned, Seconded and Passed.

NCPS should put on a class for ROs. Need to be a NCPS member to pick up the NCPS key from the FSC office.
